

## **Two Hour Delay Procedure**

**For the first time in years, Benson Village School will have a two-hour delay option in the event of dangerous winter weather or other emergencies. The decision to delay the opening of a school is made as soon as possible by the Superintendent of Addison Rutland Supervisory Union.**

Once a decision has been made, an announcement will be provided via a PowerSchool phone broadcast within the Addison Rutland Supervisory Union region by 6:30 am. School closings and delayed openings are also posted on the BVS Facebook Page.

In the case of a delayed opening, the start of school will be two hours later than the usual time.

### **Two-hour delay:**

- School opens at 9:45 am. A light breakfast will be available. The school day will begin at 10:00 am.
- If the delay happens on a Tuesday, Thursday or Friday, there will be no morning Preschool. If the delay happens on a Monday, Wednesday or Friday, preschool sessions would begin at the regularly scheduled time of 11:30 am.
- All buses will run two hours later than normal. (For example: If your bus time is 7:10 am, and it is a two-hour delay, your bus time would be 9:10 am.)
- A delayed opening has no effect on dismissal time unless announced.
